Have A Volunteer Read: Matthew 16: 13-17

Point 1: WHO IS Jesus?

“Following Jesus is what we call discipleship. A good definition of discipleship is the process of learning to follow Jesus in all of life. Every time you see someone wearing a Steph Curry jersey, they’re being a disciple. Every time you hear someone’s singing along with Beyoncé or Justin Bieber or The Weekend or Taylor Swift, they’re being a disciple. Students in classes are being disciples. We’re all disciples.” – **Michael Nolen**

Whose disciple are you?

“To say that Jesus is the Christ is to say Jesus is our king. Jesus is our Savior. Jesus is our Lord. It means Jesus is our shield, or he’s our comforter. He’s our Victor. He’s our friend. Jesus is our hope. He’s our peace, our joy, our righteousness, our sanctification. He’s the King of kings and Lord of lords. He’s the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world... the rock who is the same yesterday, today and forever. Simon also says Jesus is the Son of the living God, which means that not only is he human, but he’s divine. Jesus is the eternal Son of God, who became a son of man. It’s hard for us to wrap our minds around the reality that Jesus is fully God and fully man.”

Point 2: WHY DID Jesus Come?

“Why did Jesus come? He came to make people new, but not just as individuals. Matthew 16:18 says, ‘You are Peter... And on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.’ Jesus didn’t come to merely save individuals, but to adopt us into a family. He says, ‘I will build my church.’ Just think about the meaning and depth of those 5 words. The church belongs to Jesus. That’s true of the church in general. It’s true of every local church. It’s true of Southwinds. This is not my church. It’s not your church. This is Jesus’ church. That means building the church is not dependent on us. He invites us to participate in his work by his grace, but he’s the one who builds his church. History shows us Jesus is keeping his promise in incredible ways.”
